## 2-3s FREE FLOW PLAY

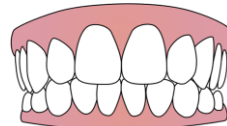

### PARADE

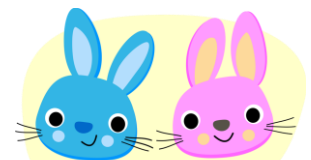
